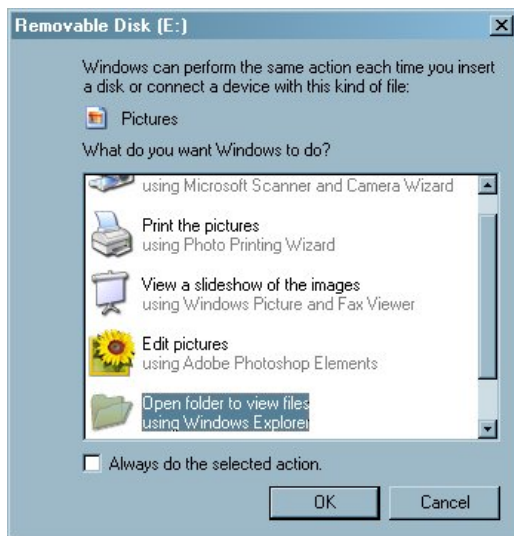


Transferring Digital Camera Photos to a Computer

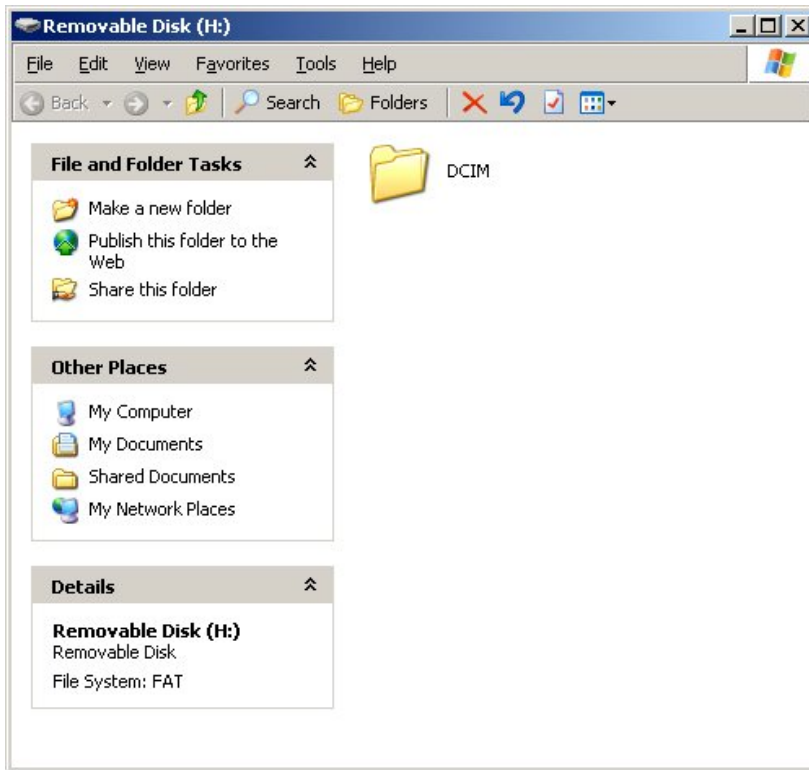
(Windows XP)

1. Turn on the computer.
2. Turn off the camera and remove the memory card.
3. Connect the card reader.
The first time you do this, Windows installs drivers for card reader. Click on the little balloons that appear in lower right corner of the screen until Windows says reader is ready to use. You can leave the card reader attached all the time if you have enough free USB ports. (You may also connect your camera directly.)
4. Insert the memory card (see the card reader instructions for the correct orientation).
Windows XP opens a screen asking what you want to do with the photos.
5. Choose “Open folder to view files.”

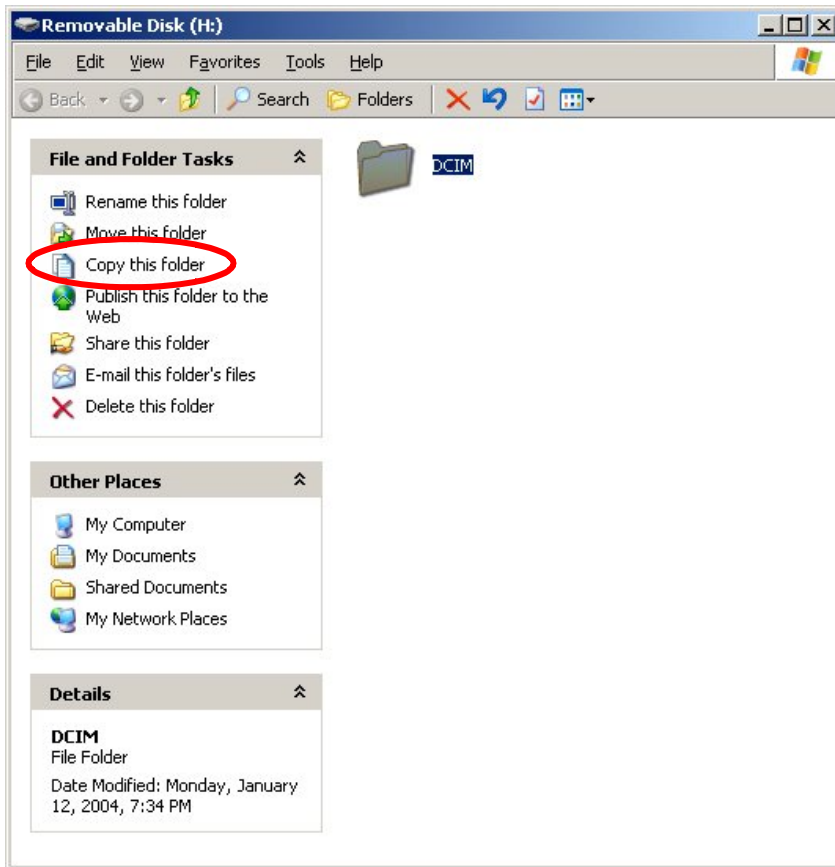


A window opens with a DCIM folder showing.

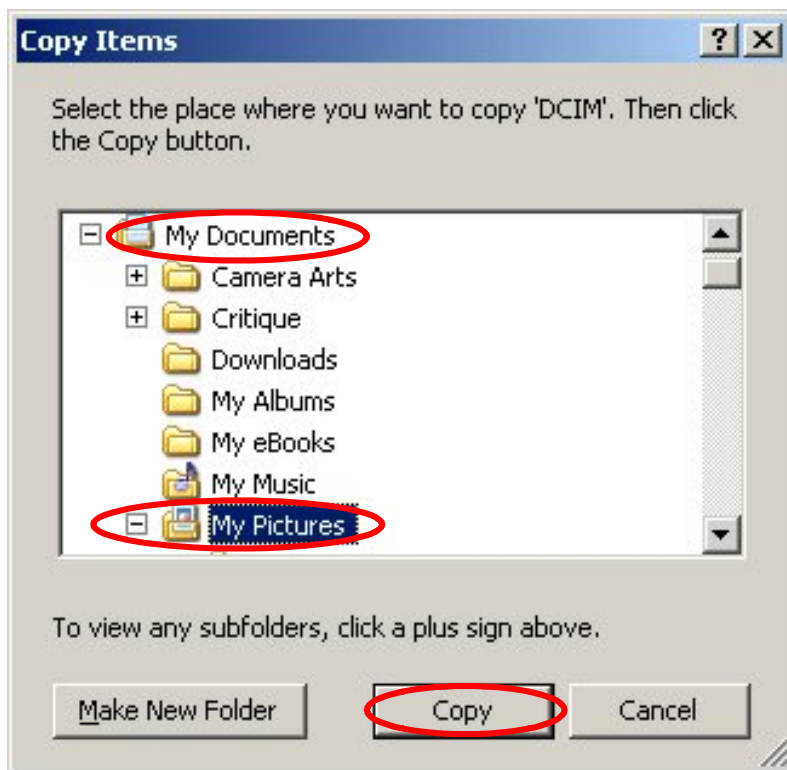
6. From the Edit menu, choose Select All.



7. In the File and Folder Tasks list on the left, click “Copy this folder.”



8. Click on My Documents.
9. Click on My Pictures.
10. Click the Copy button.

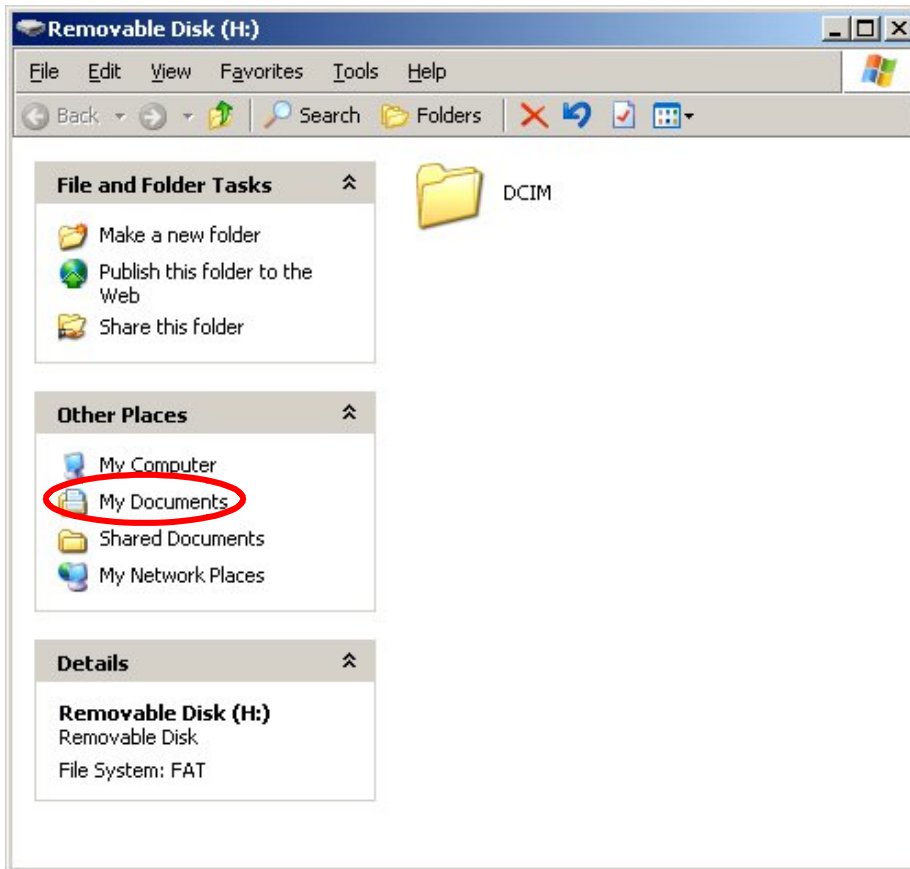


Windows copies the images to a folder on the computer.

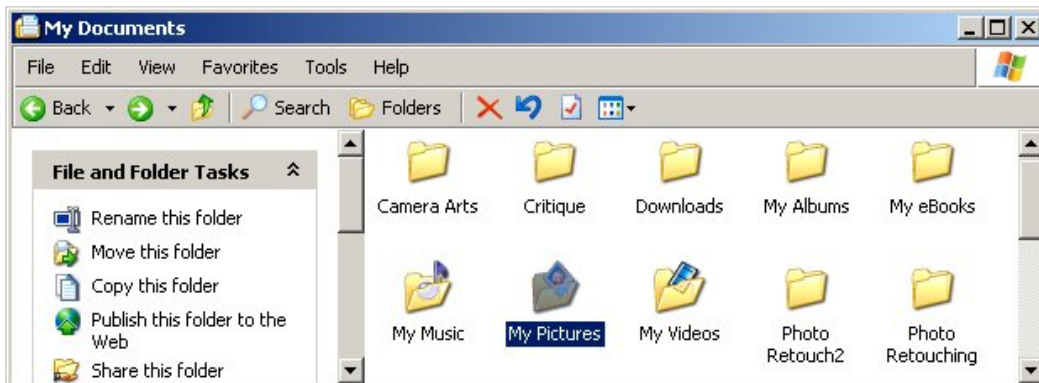


11. Remove the memory card from the reader and put it back in camera.

12. In the “Other Places” list, click once on My Documents.

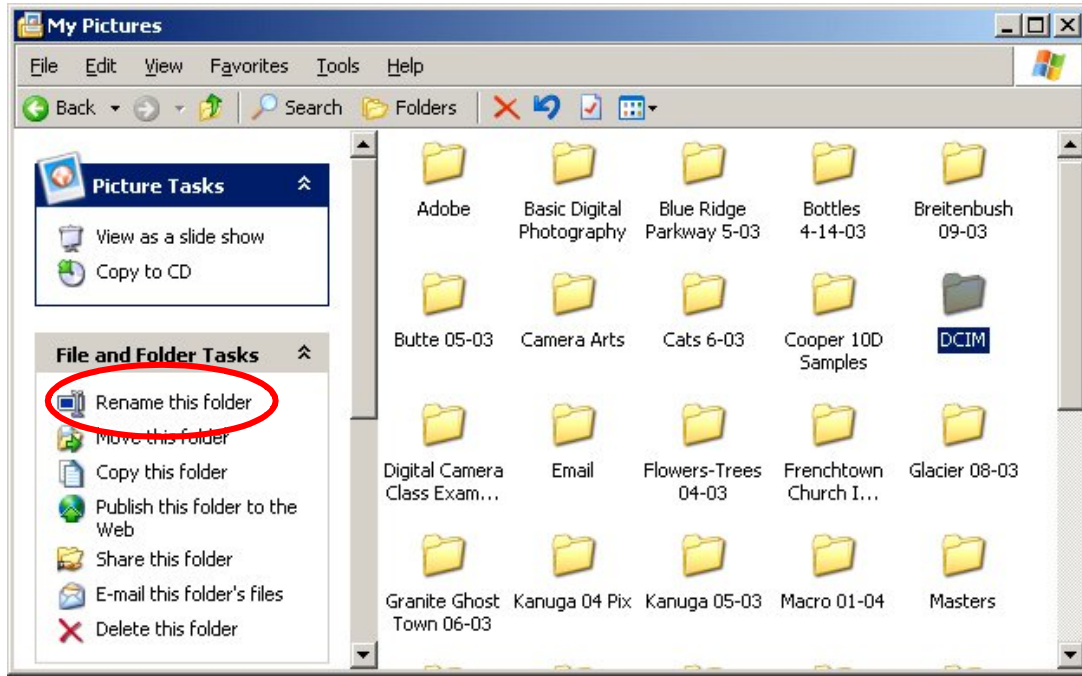


13. Double click on the My Pictures folder.



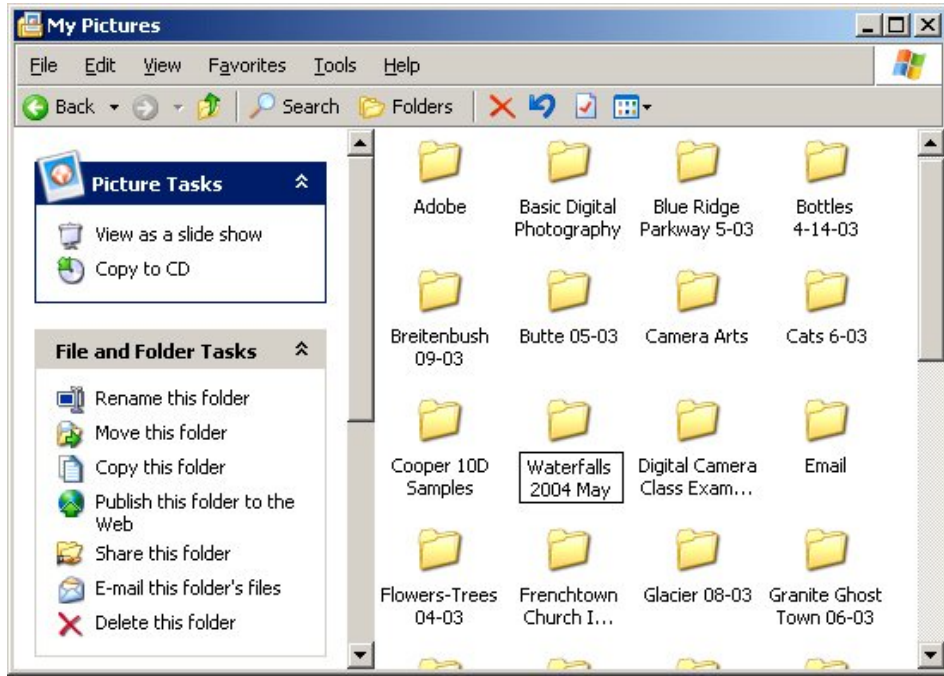
14. Click once on the DCIM folder.

15. In the File and Folder Tasks list on the left, choose “Rename this folder”.



16. Type a new name. Use the place, person or event and a date.

17. Press Enter to accept the name.

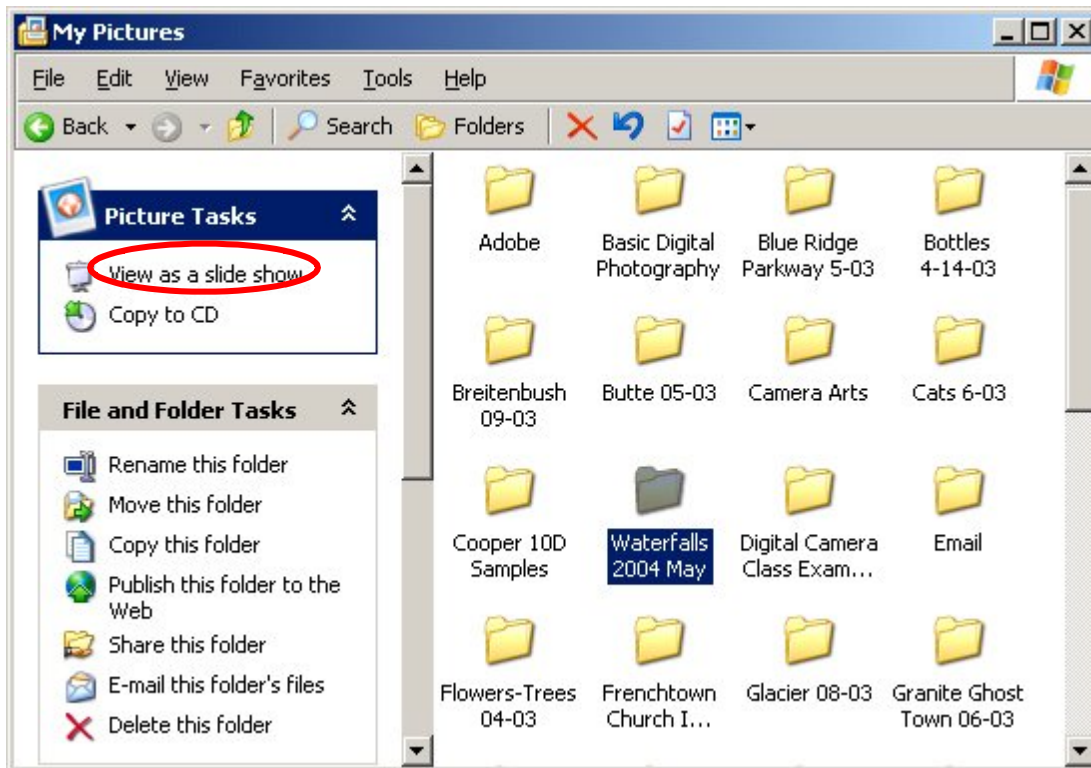


18. Erase all the photos using the camera menus (see camera manual). **DO NOT** erase photos with the computer. Doing so may cause the card to become unrecognized by the camera.

Reviewing Digital Photos

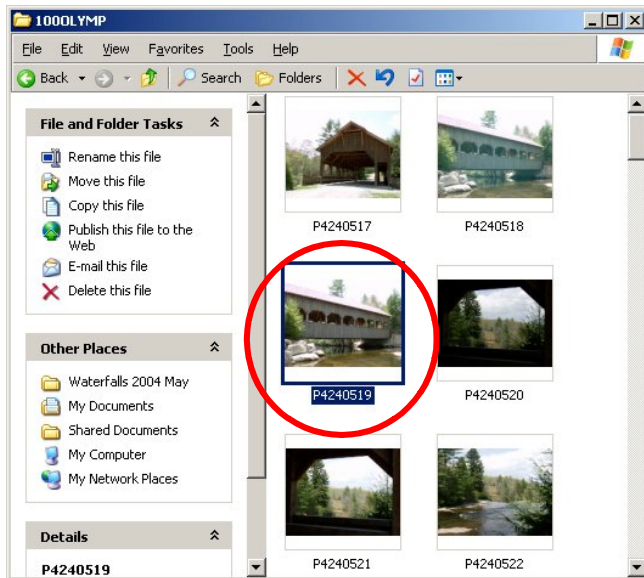
(Windows XP)

1. To see the images as a slide show, from the Picture Tasks list, click on “View as slide show”. Press the ESC key to quit the show.
NOTE: Only JPG and TIF format files are displayed, not RAW files.



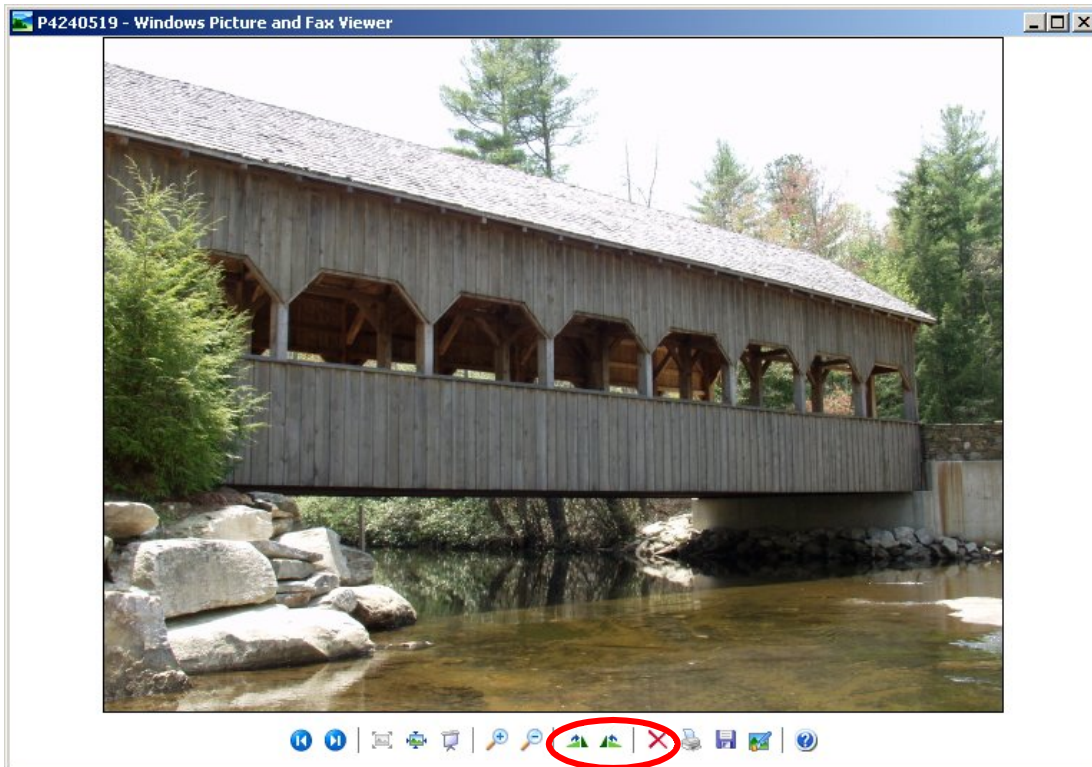
2. To view the photos one at a time, double click on the new folder to open it. If there are more folders inside, double click to open one of them.

3. From the **View** menu, choose **Thumbnails**.



4. **Double click** on a picture to display a larger view.

5. Use the **right and left arrow** keys on the keyboard to see the next and previous picture.
6. Click on the **Rotate arrows** below the photo to turn it right side up.
7. Click on the **red X** below the picture to delete it.

8. When you are finished, close the window.

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
